Sir Dr.M.S.Gosavi, Founder Director of J.D.C Bytco IMSR

Outstanding management scientist, Dr.M.S.Gosavi has contributed to the evolution of management education in Maharashtra. Born to a cultured family of Satara (1935) inspired by his father, a Sanskrit scholar late S.J.Gosavi Phalthankar and by some of the eminent luminaries of Pune, young Mr. Gosavi achieved distinction at the formal school and university levels. He was the first in the state of Maharashtra to get the doctorate in business administration from Poona University.

### **Principal ship**

Dr. Gosavi has set a world record – the youngest principal with longest tenure. At the age of 22, he became the principal of a full-fledged College of Commerce, Nashik and created a history of sports by mantling this honor for 37 years till he attained the superannuation in 1995.

With his aim of making university education rather entrepreneurial, he founded the JDC Bytco Institute of Management Studies & Research, Nashik in 1968. This institution added new dimensions to higher education.
